ERASMUS-Day (3rd Edition) @ Okayama University - April-11th-2023

On April-11th-2023, a 3rd Edition of the ERASMUS-Day (Okayama) was held at the International House, on the Tsushima Campus of Okayama University. The full day international event was opened by an Introduction of main features of ERAMUS+ (2021-2027) delivered on line from the EU Delegation in Tokyo (Richard Kelner). Then several japanese and International Universities partnering in ERASMUS were given the opportunity to introduce their ERASMUS strategies, achievements and highlights together with a number of ERASMUS mobility experience testimonies in both ways. A series of "Special" talks, focused on MSCA HORIZON EUROPE projects where Okayama University is a major player were also delivered either online (from Czech Republic and Poland for instance) or in physical presence on site. HESPRI (URL) was in particular depicted by the IEED partner. The special talks also detailed the ways ERASMUS mobilities could create the conditions of large scale International Consortiums. This was the case of MSCA proposals such as NETSU and SHARP currently under evaluation.

Pr. Nasu, newly appointed President of Okayama University attended the event and delivered a brief Greetings address at the beginning of the afternoon session. In the conclusions and perspectives section, Dr. B. Chenevier who organised the event mentioned the next Edition of ERASMUS-Day at Okayama University (2025). He noticed the progressively growing attendance over time at the ERASMUS day event and proposed to extend the next Edition to 2 days. The 2025 event would in particular include a Poster session and an additional section more specifically oriented to International and Japanese students.
